



Guidelines on how to keep yourself, other customers and our team safe when we reopen

Please visit the pub only if you feel well

On arrival wash your hands or use a sanitizer

Respect other peoples personal space. Do not move the furniture. It has been positioned for social distancing. Two households are allowed indoors or outdoors and up to 6 people from different households are allowed outdoors. Please follow Government social distancing guidelines

Keep children seated and supervise them during toilet visits

Keep all dogs on leads

All customers will be seated at a table upon arrival. No drinks will be served at the bar. Full table service will be given for food and drink

We have had to reduce the number of tables inside and outside. We strongly advise to book a table in advance as we cannot serve you if we do not have a table available

Please use the front door to enter the pub and the garden door to exit the pub

We will be undertaking much more frequent cleaning and sanitising of the pub including the toilets

Some doors may be wedged open. This is to increase ventilation and to avoid contact with handles
